Hereinafter called as **FOUNDERS of the TRUST** which expression shall wherever the context so permits mean and include their successors-in-office and;

WHEREAS the Founders of the Trust are desirous of promoting Education They also are desirous of promoting Medical facilities and

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provide help and succour to the poor and deserving for the benefit of the PUBLIC at large by constituting a Public Charitable Trust without profit motive and without discrimination of the Religion, Caste, Creed etc., with objects and constitution as hereinafter set forth;

WHEREAS the said objects in view, the FOUNDERS of the TRUST have decided to contribute a sum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) each thus totally Rs. 2,75,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh seventy five Thousand Only) to be held as initial corpus of the Trust.

WHEREAS it is necessary and desirable to declare and constitute the said TRUST and to record the objects and constitution of the said TRUST in writing.

NOW THIS DEED OF DECLARATON OF THE TRUST WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS;

I. DECLARATION OF TRUST:

1.1 The Founder Trustees of the Trust hereby declare that a sum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) each has been contributed today to carry out the objects and purposes of the Trust subject to the terms and conditions contained in this document. TRUSTEES means and include all the Trustees as described in this presents and these Trustees as appointed, nominated selected by the remaining members of the Trust.

1.2 The name and style of the Trust is "LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL DISTRICT 324 BI EDUCATIONAL TRUST" herein after shortly called as "LCI DIST 324B1 EDUCATIONAL TRUST".

1.3 The principal place of the Trust at present is situated at Door No.30, Lions Club Road, Ramnagar, Coimbatore – 641 009.

The Trust may have the office, if necessary, at such other places as the Trustee may decide.

1.4 The Trust shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the date of registration of this Trust Deed.

II. CORPUS OF THE TRUST:

The Corpus of the Trust shall include the above said payment of Rs. 2 75, 000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Seventy Five Thousand Only) contributed by the Founder Trustees of the Trust. Contributions and donations including all movable and immovable properties received by the Trust in future from time to time and all properties, assets-movable and immovable-properties of every description, investments of every type together with the income and accrual and additions thereon, to be, held and owned by the Trust on the same terms and conditions in future.

III. MEMBERSHIP OF THE TRUST:

- 3.1 The membership of the Trust consists of two types of Members namely Trust Member and Patron Member. Any Lion member of any Lions Club coming under Dist 324 B1 is eligible to become either Trust member or Patron member of the Trust upon appropriate application and approval by the Trust Board.
- 3.2 The Founder Trustees can appoint more Trustees with the approval of $2/3^{\rm rd}$ majority of the prevailing Trustees in office. To become a Trust member on future, the qualified Lion so approved as above shall contribute a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs only) to the Corpus of the Trust. The Trustees so appointed shall have equal rights and Voting power as the Existing Trustees have both in Trust Board Meeting and in Annual General Meeting.

3.3 If in future to become a Patron Member of the Trust, the qualified Lion so approved shall contribute a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One

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Lakh only) to the Corpus of the Trust. The admission of Patron Member shall also be approved by $2/3^{rd}$ majority of the prevailing Trust Board. The Patron member so admitted has voting Rights only in the Annual General Meeting and he has no voting rights in Trust Board meeting.

- **3.4** Any Patron member, who opts to become a trustee in Trust Board, shall contributes further sum as decided by the Trust Board from time to time subject to his option is approved by the Existing Trust Board. Such Patron member so elected as member of the Trust Board shall have rights as existing Trustees have, and voting rights to cast his vote both in Trust meeting and in Annual General Body Meeting.
- **3.5** The ruling Governor of District 324 B1, who holds the post of the Governor for only one year, shall be appointed as EX-OFFICIO member of the Trust during his/her tenure of one year.
- **3.6** If any Lions Club comes under District 324 B1, opts to become a member of the Trust such club shall contribute a sum of Rs.5,00,000/-(Rupees Five lakhs only) towards corpus of the Trust. The ruling President of the Club shall be the member of Trust on rotation or any assignee of the club duly approved by the Board (Executive body) of the clubs.
- **3.7** The Board of Trustees can enhance the contributions it necessary by passing resolution approved by $2/3^{\rm rd}$ majority.

3.8 CESSATION OF TRUST MEMBER & PATRON MEMBERS:

A Trustee shall cease to be a Trustee of the Trust if he/she:

- (a) Resigns
- (b) Becomes insolvent
- (c) Demise
- (d) ceases to be a lion member of Lion Club of District 324B1

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(e) is removed by the $2/3^{rd}$ majority of the trustees of the

the activities or administration of funds of the Trust. The same procedure shall be the procedure for cassation of Patron Member also.

IV. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

4.1 The object of Trust is to establish, maintain and promote education. Initially the Trust shall start School for the benefit of the public at large. The Trust can also provide Health Care to the needy, home to the deprived, aged people, assisting relief activities and other objects of Public Utility. Without prejudice to the generality of the above, the objects of the Trust shall include:

4.2 EDUCATION:

- **4.2.1** To build, construct, establish, takeover, run, maintain, manage and/or render financial help to any educational and/or scientific institutions for imparting education in Arts, Crafts, Science, Medical, Engineering, Vocational Technical subjects or for research in any of the above.
- **4.2.2** The broader aim is this trust is to support school students, socially, technically and financially, so that they can attain educational qualifications of their capabilities.
- **4.2.3** Activities like identifying deserving candidates, providing them with financial, material and technical aids, guiding them through various educational options, sponsoring their higher education, helping them to get bank loans, etc.

4.2.4 To promote the Development of Art, Culture and Literature, Architect, Painting, Graphic, Sculpture, Music, Dance and Drama for the preservation of old historical monuments and for the benefit of public in general. The Trust can also promote sports and Athletic activities.

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4.2.6 To establish libraries, art galleries, museums, auditoriums, and Halls for Seminars and functions for the use of public in general, Publication of books periodicals, and Publication of other forms of education and general awareness media like audio/video tapes, films, etc.

4.2.7 To give scholarships, grants, reward to the students during their study period or during their training.

4.2.8 Construct, to take on lease, maintains promote and to extend boarding houses, hostels for students and working women. Construct, to take on lease, maintain, promote and to extend quarters or staff colonies to the all working staffs including faculty members.

4.2.9 To acquire transport vehicles and run the same for the benefit of the students and staffs.

4.3 HOSPITAL:

4.3.1 To provide general medical relief by subscribing to or establishing charitable dispensaries, hospitals, clinics, and/or to give medical relief to poor and general public.

4.3.2 To establish, construct, to take on lease, maintain and make extension to hospitals. To make necessary arrangements for the

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development of medical sciences. Conduct medical camps either individually or along with any other institutions or trust or service societies.

4.3.3 To impart education to public on Health, environment, conduct exhibitions, street shows, publicity, etc, to create and promote awareness about general hygiene, promotion of general health and prevention from diseases and epidemics.

4.4 HOME FOR THE AGED, ORPHAN & WOMEN:

- 4.4.1 To establish, construct, maintain and promote homes for the aged. Admission of old age people deprived by the family members or aged orphans into the home. To involve in activities of creating respect and responsibility on the aged parents by their family members. Imparting training in handicrafts or such other possible work for self-employment to the aged people. Granting loans or grants to the aged for such selfemployment. Making arrangements for the marketing the products manufactured by the aged. And such other activities of maintenance, promotion and encouragement of the aged. Establishing burial grounds and making arrangements for the funeral of deceased old age people.
- To establish public halls and social centers and giving the 4.4.2 same free of cost or at concessional cost to the poor and needy,
- 4.4.3 To construct, to take on lease, maintain promote and to extend boarding houses, hostels for students and working women.

4.4.4 To construct, to take on lease, maintain promote and to extend home for orphan children and provide all necessary inputs to enlighten their future.

4.4.5 To carry out any other philanthropic and religious public charitable activities, which the Trust is capable of doing.

V. DONATIONS AND CONTRIBUTIONS:

The Trustees shall have power and discretion to accept upon such terms as they shall think fit, any donations, grants, subscriptions aid Foreign Aids and contributions from LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION (LCIF) any Government, Local Authority, Corporation, firm or other persons or from any Charitable or other institution, whether they may be in Money or other movable or immovable property for the purposes of the Trust.

VI. INVESTMENTS:

All money, which shall not immediately be required for current expenses, shall be invested by the Trust in bank deposits, properities and in any suitable assets they may deem fit. However the Trustees shall ensure that such investments are in accordance with and as per the relevant provisions of the Income Tax Act, as applicable to such Public Charitable Trusts from time to time.

VII. ADMINISTRATION OF THE TRUST

• The TRUST shall be administered by an **EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE** which consists of the following office bearers:-

- 1. Managing Trustee
- 2. Joint Managing Trustee (3 Nos)
- 3. Secretary
- 4. Treasurer
- 5. Executive Committee Members (5 Nos)



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The first Executive Committee shall consist of the following Trustees.

The First Executive Committee shall hold office for 5 years from the date of commencement of Trust. The subsequent Executive Committee shall be elected by the Trustees once in every 2 (Two) years. The outgoing office bearers are eligible for re-election for any office in the Executive Committee.

7.2 FUNCTIONING OF THE TRUST

7.2.1 The Trustees shall have powers to frame rules for the efficient functioning of the Trust, which shall not be repugnant to any of the objects or any other clauses of these presents and without prejudice to the generality of the above.

(a) All the Executive Committee Trust members shall participate in all

day to day activities of the Trust.

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- (b) The Trustees are not entitled for any remuneration for the services rendered by them to the Trust.
- (c) On all the matters regarding changes in the objects and investments, the decision of the Board of Trustees at a meeting by resolution shall be necessary.
- (d) In the temporary absence of the Managing Trustee, the Joint Managing Trustee will undertake the activities of the Managing Trustees on Administrative matters.
- **7.2.2** The Trust shall be at liberty to donate to any other Trust or Trusts having objects similar to those of these presents.
- **7.2.3** The Trust shall be entitled to and be at liberty to accept gifts or any voluntary contribution, Foreign Aid either in money or in kind from any person for and on behalf of the Trust.

VIII. MEETINGS & RESOLUTIONS

- **8.1** The Managing Trustee shall act as Chairman of the meeting and preside over all the meetings of the Trust. In his absence any one of the Joint Managing Trustees shall preside. The Trustees shall choose someone among the Trustees present to preside over the meeting, if all the four are absent.
- **8.2** The Quorum to conduct the meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be $1/3^{rd}$ of the total numbers of Trustees.
- **8.3** On any matter, in which there is no unanimity of opinion among all the Trustees the decision of 2/3 majority of the members present in the meeting in which the particular matter is under discussion shall prevail and shall be passed as approved.

8.4 Any resolution passed in the meeting by $2/3^{\text{rd}}$ majority of the members present in the meeting shall be valid and binding.

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8.5 A Minute book shall be maintained in which the proceedings of every meeting of the Trustees shall be recorded by the Secretary and shall be signed by the Chairman of that meeting.

IX. POWERS OF THE MANAGING TRUSTEE AND OTHER TRUSTEES:

- **9.1** The Managing Trustee shall have all powers necessary or incidental for effectually carrying out the objects of the trust.
- **9.2** The Trustees shall exercise the following powers at their Board meetings provided however, that the power incidental to the day to day management of the Trust may be exercised by the Managing Trustee acting by himself.
- i) To employ clerks: and other employees: agents: bankers: brokers: lawyers: Accountants and others at such remuneration as they think fit:
- ii) To delegate any powers as they can lawfully delegate, to any person and to execute such power of attorney as they may think fit for the purpose.
- iii) To withdraw any power to revoke any appointment of any employees or attorney.
- iv) To buy, or take lease, immovable property from any person for the Trust and/or put up, pull down, rebuild, add to, alter, repair, improve, buildings or structures on the land belonging to or under the control and possession of the Trust:

v) To sell, alienate, give out on lease or license, mortgage, charge, surrender, pledge, hypothecate, transfer deal with or otherwise - dispose of all or any of the properties, funds and assets of the trust (movable or immovable) for the purpose of reinvestment of the proceeds in such other form of investment as would, in the opinion of the trustees be beneficial to the trust., wherever necessary.

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vi) To sub-lease or let out any portion of any immovable property in possession in future or under the control of the trust in future at such rent and for such period and on such terms and conditions as they may think fit in order to apply the income derived there from for the objects of the trust.

vii) To accept properties upon trust and/or surrender of lease interest in any -property both movable and immovable with liabilities or onerous obligations provided, however, that the trustees are satisfied that the market value of the properties would meet the onerous liabilities or obligations or undertakings. The decision of the Trustees in this regard shall be final and binding

viii) To enter into contracts for and on behalf of the Trust.

ix) To institute, conduct, defend, compound or abandon any legal proceedings by or against the Trust or Trustees and allow time for payment or satisfaction of any debt, dues or any claim or demand by or against the Trust.

x) To settle out of Court, compromise or compound all suits, actions and other proceedings and all differences and demand and to refer all or any of such differences or demands to arbitration and to execute release and to settle and improve all accounts without being answerable for any loss occasioned thereby.

xi) To obtain payment of money from all Courts, Banks, Government Officials, Treasury Officials Assignees, Official Receivers, Post Office and all other Offices of the Central. States or Local Authorities:-

Assurances or any other officials appointed for registration of deeds, assurances, documents, and other instruments, to execute or be present and admit execution, and register or cause to be registered, deed, assurances, documents, etc., in which the Trust is interested or involved.

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xiii) To borrow monies from anybody including the Trustees for the purposes of the Trust on such terms and conditions as may be agreed to by the Trustees and to authorize any one or more of them to execute such documents including the deed of mortgage, charge of hypothecation as may be necessary for the said purpose and also to create any mortgage or charge or any of the Trust properties movable or immovable for the said purpose.

xiv) To make and from time to time to repeal, add or alter regulations as to the management of the Trust and the affairs thereof provided that the same shall not be inconsistent with the objects and other provisions contained in these presents; and

xv) Generally to do and perform all things required or necessary to be done or performed in or about these presents and for the purpose of the management of the Trust.

xvi) In respect of any activity of the trust while discharging the duties, the Trustees must have prior concurrence of the Managing Trustee.

X. PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

10.1 The Trustees shall meet at periodical intervals atleast once in three months, either at the office of the Trust or at such other place or places as may be convenient to them, for the purpose of implementing the objects of the Trust and for finalizing the ways and means by which such objects shall be implemented and for considering any matter connected with the Trust or its affairs or to transact any business of the Trust.

10.2 The Trustees may make Rules for regulating their meetings not being inconsistent with any provisions contained in these presents and they may make rules for passing any resolutions by circulation among the Trustees and the Trustees may repeal or alter any rules made

pursuant to this clause.

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
- 10.3 A meeting of the Trustees may be called by Managing Trustee by giving not less than seven days notice in writing specifying the date, place and hour of such meetings and the nature of the business to be transacted at the meeting and such notice shall be sent by post or any digital mode delivered to every Trustee. The accidental omission to give notice to or the non-receipt of notice by any Trustee shall not invalidate the proceedings at any such meeting. With the consent of all the Trustees a meeting may be convened by such shorter notice as in such manner as the Trustees may think fit.
- 10.4 The other Trustees may also request the Managing Trustee in writing to convene an extraordinary meeting to transact an emergency issue. Such request letter shall bear the signatures of $1/3^{\rm rd}$ majority of the total Trustees. The managing Trustees shall convene such meeting on receiving the request letter.
- 10.5 The required Quorum to conduct the proceedings of the Board meeting shall be $1/3^{\rm rd}$ of members of the Trust and the quorum to pass any resolution shall be $2/3^{\rm rd}$ of the members present in the meeting.

XI. GENERAL BODY AND ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:

11.1 The General Body consists of both categories of Trust members and Patron members. The Trust shall conduct the Annual General Body meeting to place the decisions of Trust Board and accounts of the Trust. The meeting shall be held within six months of the succeeding year.

11.2 The required Quorum to conduct the proceedings of the Annual General Meeting shall be $1/3^{rd}$ of the total Trust and Patron members. The required Quorum to pass any resolution shall be $2/3^{rd}$ of the members present at the meeting.

11.3 Each member can cast only one Vote for issues. If there is any tie, the Managing Trustee can cast one more vote to decide the issue.



Managing Trustees or any one of his assignee shall have the custody of all deeds, documents of title relating to Trust properties and investments and the books of accounts and other records relating to the Trust and shall be responsible for the same.

XIII. BANK ACCOUNT:

- 13.1 All income, subscriptions and donations for the general purposes of the Trust and the income from investments and all other moneys from time to time forming part of the general revenue of the Trust shall, on the same being received, be paid into a bank account with any Scheduled bank, Nationalised bank or any other suitable bank.
- **13.2** Bank accounts shall be operated by the Treasurer Jointly with either Managing Trustee or Secretary.

XIV. ACCOUNTS:

- **14.1** The Trustees shall keep proper accounts of the income and expenditure of the Trust and shall prepare a financial statement and balance sheet for every year as on the last day of March of every year.
- 14.2 The accounts of every year shall be audited by a qualified Chartered Accountant or firm of qualified Chartered Accountants who shall be appointed for the purpose by the Trustee and the audited accounts shall be placed at a meeting of the trustees, and General Body meeting which shall be held within six months of the succeeding year.

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- 15.1 The Trust may give donations to any other institution or Trust or Societies having similar objectives or to any fund established by the Government.
- 15.2 The activities of the services of the Trust shall be open to all irrespective of Gender and their Nationality, Religion, Caste, Class or Sex
- **15.3** The activities and services of the Trust shall be confined to the Union of India. No activity shall be carried out outside India.
- **15.4** The activities and services of the Trust shall be wholly for charitable purpose. The Trust shall not carry out any activity with the intention of earning profit. The Trust shall not carry out business, unless such business is incidental to the attainment of the, objectives of the Trust.
- 15.5 The founder Trustees of the trust hereby declare that this declaration of trust shall be irrevocable and for the benefit of the general public and that all interest and income received by Trustee under presents as well as the corpus of any money received by them shall always be used and applied for and in furtherance of the several-objects and purposes mentioned and specified hereinabove. The entire operation of the Trust will be only with in india.

15.6 The Trust irrevocable, if for reasons, the objects of the Trust could not be carried out or accomplished, the Trust shall be extinguished and in such an event the Board of Trustees shall apply the funds of the Trust in discharging the liabilities or the Trust and the remainder of the corpus. If any, shall be handed over institution having similar objects of this Trust.

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15.7 All the funds and income of the Trust shall be solely utilized only towards the objects of the trust and no portion of it shall be utilized for payment to trustee by way of profit, interest, dividends, etc.,

15.8 The Trustees may at their discretion vary any investments and securities held by the Trust provided however that the trust funds and all monies in their hands which may require investment shall be in such securities or investments as are permitted under the Income Tax Act from time to time.

15.9 It is declared and understood that any amendments to this Trust Deed shall be carried out only with prior approval of the Commissioner of Income-tax or such other competent statutory authorities and as approved by the Board of Trustees.lub

XVI. POWER TO ALTER OBJECTS:

The trustees shall have full power and authority to include a new clause, amend, alter and rescind of existing clauses of the Trust for the convenience of the Management and Administration of the Trust, by passing a resolution with $2/3^{\rm rd}$ majority. It is declared and understood that all amendments to this Trust deed shall be carried only with the approval of the Commissioner of Income-tax or any Authority specified under any law of the time being in force.

XVII. INDEMNITY:

The Trustees shall at all time stand indemnified, in respect of any act that they may have bonafidely done, suffered or omitted to be done in respect of matters relating to the Trust.

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XVIII. RESIDUARY:

For matters not provided for in these presents, the provision of the Indian Trust Act or any other law enacted in its place and rules made there under will apply accordingly.

As on date no movable or immovable properties are involved in this Trust.
